



Girl Scouts of Greater Los Angeles Emergency After-Hours Calls

In case of serious injury, accident, emergency, or fatality involving Girl Scouts:

1. Give priority attention to ill or injured person. CALL 911 for ambulance, police and fire personnel, as needed.
2. In the event of a fatality, always notify the police. Do not disturb the victim or surroundings.
3. Place competent person in charge of group.
4. **CALL: 1-877-ICE-GSGLA (1-877-423-4752)** 24-hour emergency service to alert the council's Emergency Team. State: "I am from Girl Scouts of Greater Los Angeles" and indicate your emergency.

5. Provide name, location, and telephone number you are calling from.
6. Stay on the phone until your call is connected to a member of the Emergency Team. If you are not patched through immediately to an Emergency Team member, make sure a responsible adult is accessible by phone until the call is returned.
7. Notify the emergency contact on medical/permission form, as appropriate.
8. File Incident/Accident Report with your local Service Center within 24 hours.
